

Performance Bursary

Welsh Gymnastics' vision is to create great communities and champions through gymnastics. The 'Performance Bursary' aims to alleviate financial stress for those individuals who are at a disadvantage due to their location in Wales. The bursary will support a selection of Welsh Gymnastics members on a Performance Pathway, to continue participating in their club and attend Welsh squad sessions.

Members who fit at least one of the below criteria are able to apply for a Performance Bursary;

- Travel more than 400 miles per week to attend club/Welsh squad sessions
- Travel more than 100-mile round trip to a Welsh Gymnastics organised squad session at least once a week
- Requires accommodation to attend a Welsh squad session
- Required to travel more than a 250-mile round trip to attend a monthly Welsh squad session

The following squads are included in the Performance Bursary;

- Men's Artistic – Foundation, Development, Performance
- Rhythmic – Foundation, Development, Performance
- Trampoline - National
- Women's Artistic – Foundation, Development, Performance
- WG Funded Disciplines - Home Nations Squads Only

The amount of bursary that can be awarded is assessed on a case-by-case basis and will not normally exceed £250 for individuals. Please see notes for application below for more details.

Bursary Application

Our 'Performance Bursary' aims to provide some financial support for Welsh Gymnastics members on a Performance Pathway who may face some challenges due to their geographical location.

Applications are usually accepted around two/three points throughout the year. Applications will be considered on an as needs basis.

Funding is limited per year and requests can be for as little as £20, but grants awarded will not usually exceed £250.

Applicants:

- Must have membership of Welsh Gymnastics
- All sections of the applications must be completed
- The application must be endorsed by a club official
- Each individual can only apply once in the financial year
- Must meet at least one of the previously stated criteria
- Must be a current member of one of the Welsh Squads included in the previously stated list
- Must not have received any Talent Cymru or Sports Aid Funding within the financial year
- Must not have received any 'Access Gymnastics' funding within the financial year
