

# Welsh Gymnastics WAG Development Squad Selection Policy

Updated: 14 February 2024

## **Eligibility Criteria**

To be eligible for selection to the Women's Artistic Development Squad the following conditions apply:

- a) Gymnasts must be current members of Welsh / British Gymnastics.
- b) Gymnasts must fulfil the eligibility criteria to compete for Wales as published on the Welsh Gymnastics website or be residing in Wales.
- c) Gymnast's payment for Welsh Squad membership fees and / or contribution payments for training camps must be up to date for squad selection or re-selection consideration.
- d) Gymnasts who are turning 10 13 in year (2014 2011).

#### **Selection Criteria**

Numbers are selected at the discretion of the Welsh National Coaches and are dependent on identified potential within each age group. In April 2023, 10 gymnasts were selected. Selection will be following a trial and considering performance during identified competitions:

## **Primary factors**

- a) Scores on conditioning tests.
- b) Performance of skills on each apparatus.
- c) Performance in excel grades.
- d) Performance in voluntary competitions.

Please see attached trial criteria.

Gymnasts may be invited throughout the year at the discretion of the national coaches to attend sessions before trialling at the next opportunity / within a session. #### **Wildcards**

In some cases, athletes may be selected as a wildcard based upon the following criteria:









- a) Injury preventing full participation / performance
- b) National coach recommendation
- c) Opportunity for club or coach development
- d) Potential for further technical and skill development
- e) Unable to attend trial / selection day for a significant reason\*

\*Gymnasts who are unable to trial due to extenuating circumstances e.g., illness / injury, or a pre-booked holiday will be able to trial at the first session of the squad. They will still have to been entered on GymNet and a Dr's note provided in the case of injury / illness.

## **Appeals Process**

- 1. Appeals must be submitted within 3 days of communication of selection for a non-selected gymnast.
- 2. The Appellant can only make appeals or, where they are under the age of 18, their parent or guardian.
- 3. The Appellant does not have a right of appeal against any judgment or discretion exercised in the course of making a nomination decision, or against the content of the applicable selection criteria.
- 4. Appeals should be sent to <a href="mailto:elle.langham-walsh@welshgymnastics.org">elle.langham-walsh@welshgymnastics.org</a> outlining grounds for appeal.
- 5. An appeals panel consisting of a National Coach alongside three persons who are knowledgeable of the selection process, however, have not been involved in the non-nomination of the Appellant.
- 6. Upon the receipt of the Notice of Appeal the Independent Appeal Panel will convene a meeting to take place as soon as reasonably possible.
- 7. The decision of the Independent Appeal Panel shall be reached by majority vote and all members of the Panel shall have a vote each.
- 8. The decision of the Independent Appeal Panel shall be final, and the Appellant will be notified following the Independent Appeal Panel meeting.
