7. Additional Performance Factors	In the absence of a sufficient number of athletes achieving the performance standards, the nomination panel may take into consideration gymnasts who do not reach the performance standards due to injury, illness or other key factors that have had a detrimental effect on training and competition plans based on supporting the longer-term direction of the discipline.
	The panel will consider the following Additional Performance Factors (APF)
	when selecting gymnasts:
	a. Gymnasts scoring potential to win a medal or achieve the performance
	targets at the Home Nations Competition.
	b. Current and most recent performance form in the build-up to nomination, including performances at the Designated Selection Event
	(DSE).
	c. Current medical and injury status including recent training history and
	any additional extenuating circumstances that the panel feels necessary

	to consider. d. To provide development opportunities and exposure to gymnasts in line with the long term aims of the discipline.
8. Selection Panel	The selection panel will consist of:
	 Executive Director of Performance / Performance Programme Manager / Performance Programme Officer Head Rhythmic National Coach Non-Performance Team WG Staff Member Athlete Representative (where available)
9. Selection Process for Gymnasts	A gymnast who meets the eligibility criteria but does not meet the Performance Standards (Section 6) can be considered for selection by the panel and these gymnasts will be identified at the start of the selection panel discussions using relevant information aligned to the Additional Performance Factors (Section 7). The nominated gymnasts and coaches will be those, in the expert opinion of the nomination panel, most able to achieve the targets listed in Performance Targets (Section 2).
10. Selection Process for Coaches and Support Staff	Selection of nominated coaches and judges will be made at the selection panel meeting held w/b/ 14 th April 2025. Selection of nominated coaches will be made based on the best interests of the team and development of workforce in line with WG Strategy. Officials/support staff with the required qualifications will be contacted regarding availability. Selections of these individuals will be made on appropriateness of the opportunity and availability.
11. Expectations of selected gymnasts, coaches and support staff	The selected delegation members must agree to adhere to the relevant Welsh Gymnastics policies, procedures, and codes of conduct.
12. Communication of selections	Team selection (gymnasts, coaches and officials) communicated to athletes & coaches no later than 18 th April 2025.
13. Appeals	Appeals may only be submitted from communication of selection until end of play on 20 th April 2025 for non-selected gymnasts on the grounds that the process outlined within this selection policy has not been adhered to. Appeals must be submitted in writing by the gymnast (personal coach if under 18 years) and sent to performance@welshgymnastics.org between the
	Appeals will be dealt with by an independent panel who were not initially involved in the decision-making process.
14. Injury and	In the event of an injury and/or the need for replacement, the selection panel will
replacement	decide about bringing the gymnasts listed as a reserve into the team at any time.
