

Women's Artistic Area Squad Coach (South-East, South-Central, North)

Role Summary

The Welsh Gymnastics Women's Artistic Area Squad Coach is responsible for the development and delivery of high-quality training sessions for gymnasts and coaches within the area squad programme. The role involves collaborating with the Women's Artistic National Coaching team, to ensure the planning and delivery of area squad sessions.

This individual will play a key role in coach education, fostering a positive performance culture, and embedding the values of Welsh Gymnastics within the programme.

Main areas of responsibility:

- Deliver a person-centred approach to coaching.
- Deliver training sessions to identified gymnasts and coaches as appropriate and agreed with the discipline coaching team.
- Ensure all activities are delivered in line with Welsh Gymnastics and Home Nations policies.
- Provide knowledge transfer opportunities to coaches working within the area squad programme.
- The role holder has a responsibility to ensure they comply with Welsh Gymnastics and Home Nations policies. Highlight any known issues within the organisation and with associated partners.

Role Requirements

Essential

- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Good decision-making skills.
- Experience disseminating knowledge.
- Planning and leading sessions.
- Hold a minimum level 2 coaching qualification in Women's Artistic Gymnastics.
- Hold current WG / BG gold / national membership.
- Hold an enhanced with barring list criminal records check through WG / BG.
- Hold current Welsh Gymnastics approved Safeguarding and Protecting Children certificate.

Desirable

- An active coach at an WG affiliated Club (Preferable).
- Hold a minimum level 3 coaching qualification in Women's Artistic Gymnastics.
