1.Introduction	The Caledonia International is a development competition and target event for Acro in 2025.		
	The nomination of gymnasts to represent Wales at the above-named event will be made according to this selection policy.		
2.Performance Targets	This competition will act as a development opportunity for gymnasts and coaches, with an aim of qualifying for finals, and taking a Team.		
3. Selection Timelines	 a) Trial to take place on Sunday 7th September 2025 at West Street Gymnastics Club b) Selection meeting to take place during the week commencing 8th September 2025. c) Team selection communication no later than the 17th September 2025. 		
4.Competition Format	The competition format will be delivered as per Caledonia International 2025 Competition rules and regulations.		
	 Day 1: Team competition and individual partnership qualifying competition Day 2: Finals day 		
5. Gymnast Eligibility Criteria	Gymnasts are eligible for consideration provided they		
	are a Welsh Citizen holding or eligible to hold a British passport		
	 Gymnasts must be age eligible (as per Caledonia International age categories and Welsh Gymnastics international trip age specifications) 		
	are a current British / Welsh Gymnastics member		
	 are eligible to compete for Welsh Gymnastics in line with the WG eligibility criteria. 		
	Gymnasts competing at the Caledonia International will be selected from the below selection event:		
	Welsh Acro Squad / Caledonia trial – 07/09/25		
	In the event that a gymnast is unable to attend the selection event outlined above, Welsh Gymnastics will be unable to accommodate alternative arrangements due to the limited timeframe for Nominative Selections.		







6. Performance Standards	The nomination panel may take into consideration injury, illness or other key factors that have had a detrimental effect on training and competition plans based on supporting the longer-term direction of the programme.
	 The panel will consider the following: a) Gymnasts scoring potential at the Caledonia International 2025. b) Current and most recent performance form in the build-up to nomination. c) Current medical and injury status including recent training history and any additional extenuating circumstances that the panel feels necessary to consider at its discretion. d) Longer term aims of the programme. e) Technical element- a minimum score of 8.00 in both routines. f) Selections will ultimately be taken from the overall score achieved from trial routines.
7.Selection Panel	The selection panel will consist of: - Acro Technical Panel - Performance Programme Officer/Manager - Independent WG staff Member - Athlete representative
8.Selection Process	Gymnasts meeting the eligibility criteria will be considered against the Performance Standards taking into account the performance targets for this competition. Selections will be made before the 17 th September 2025.
9.Injury and Replacement	In the event of injury and/or the need for replacement, the selection panel will agree from any gymnast listed as a reserve may be called upon to join the Team at any time. - A non-travelling reserve will be selected for each category.
