Selection policy

October 24th – 26th 2025



1. Introduction	The Northern European Championships is a performance competition and has been identified as a target event for 2025.
	The nomination of gymnasts and coaches to represent Wales at the above-named event will be made up according to this selection policy.
	The team for the Northern European Championships will be composed of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6 gymnasts (senior/junior*).
	*Maximum of 1 junior score counts on each apparatus towards the Team Total Option for 6 seniors if appropriate.
2. Performance Targets	 Team Top 3 Placing 2 Senior Gymnasts in Top 8 AA 2- 4 Apparatus Medals 5 - 6 Apparatus finals
3. Selection Timeline	 Selection to happen from the MAG National Set grades Championships 2025 Selection Panel to be between the 8th and 12th of September 2025 in line with the deadline for entry submission. Team selection (gymnasts, coaches, and officials) communicated to athletes and coaches no later than Wednesday 17th September 2025 (Midday). General public announcement of the team will be no later than the WC 6th October 2025.
4. Competition Format	 The competition format will be delivered as per FIG competition rules and regulations. Saturday 25th October: Individual AA Final and Team Final (C I & C II) Sunday 26th October: Apparatus Finals (C III), top 8 qualifiers from C I (Max 2 per nation)
5. Gymnast Eligibility Criteria	 Gymnasts are eligible for consideration provided they; Are eligible to hold a British passport Are eligible to compete for Welsh Gymnastics in line with the WG eligibility criteria Are age eligible as per junior and senior FIG age categories Are a current British / Welsh Gymnastics member Have competed in the Designated Selection Events (DSEs)** Have no outstanding fees or any unresolved bans via Welsh/British gymnastics Always comply with UKAD Clean Sport Policy ** Any gymnast unable to compete at the listed DSE can express in writing to the selection panel for consideration. Gymnasts are required to send an appeal in writing explaining the reasons for being unable to compete at the DSE to

informs Welsh Gymnastics that they are in this position, the selection panel, in conjunction with National Coaches will look at a viable option for inclusion within the selection process by;

A - Competing via live link at the same time as the other gymnasts at the DSE OR B – Producing footage by an agreed date (by the date of the DSE and no later). All routines must be filmed during the same session or current competition *eligible date pending*.

** Use of footage can only be considered if participating internationally or due to prior communicated conflict.

Routine footage submitted for selection consideration will be judged by the same judges as the DSE.

Age groups are as per FIG Junior and Senior code. Juniors – aged 15 in the year of competition Seniors – aged 18 in the year of competition

6. Performance Standards

Gymnasts wishing to be considered for nomination must provide evidence at the designated selection event or via agreed footage submission (see Section 5 Gymnast Eligibility Criteria) that they have the capability to contribute towards the team score objective set out in Target 1 (below) or evidence capability of achieving Targets 2 & 3 at the Northern European Championships.

- Target 1 Achieve a Team score of 300.00 (with the top 4 scores counting on each piece)
- Target 2 Potential to finish in the top 8 A/A placing
- Target 3 Potential to qualify for an apparatus Medal

7. Additional Performance Factors

In the absence of a sufficient number of athletes achieving the performance standards, the nomination panel may take into consideration gymnasts who do not reach the performance standards due to injury, illness or other key factors that have had a detrimental effect on training and competition plans based on supporting the longer-term direction of the programme of qualifying for and winning medals at the 2026 Commonwealth Games. Gymnasts who do not currently hold a Welsh Squad position are welcome to attend the DSE.

The panel will consider the following Additional Performance Factors (APF) when selecting gymnasts:

- a) Gymnasts scoring potential to win a medal or achieve the performance targets at the Northern Europeans 2025.
- b) Current and most recent performance form in the build-up to nomination, including performances at the Designated Selection Event (DSE).
- c) Current medical and injury status including recent training history and any additional extenuating circumstances that the panel feels necessary to consider.
- d) providing competition exposure to gymnasts who are eligible for the 2026 Commonwealth Games.
- e) Where a vote is split, national coaches reserve the right to have final say within team selections to ensure performance targets are adhered to as closely as possible.

8. Selection Panel	The selection panel will consist of:
	 Director of Performance / Performance Programme Manager / Officer (Voting member) National Coach(es) (Voting member(s) Technical Panel representative (Voting member)* Independent WG staff member (non-voting member) Athlete Representative (Non-voting member) *If there is a conflict-of-interest vote will be removed and replaced with a brevet
	judge.
9. Selection Process for Gymnasts	A gymnast who meets the eligibility criteria but does not meet the Performance Standards (Section 6) can be considered for selection by the panel and these gymnasts will be identified at the start of the selection panel discussions using relevant information aligned to the Additional Performance Factors (Section 7). The nominated gymnasts and coaches will be those, in the expert opinion of the nomination panel, most able to achieve the targets listed in Performance Targets (Section 2).
	Based on the event requirements, when reviewing eligible gymnasts, their performances, and the additional performance factors, a non-travelling reserve for the event will be named.
10. Expectations of selected gymnasts, coaches and support staff	 Selected gymnasts and coaches (including named reserves where agreed) will be expected to attend the Northern European Championships training camp (October 20th-23rd) in Sport Wales National Centre, Cardiff. The selected delegation members must agree to adhere to the relevant Welsh Gymnastics code of conduct during the training camp and for the duration of the trip.
11. Communication of selections	Team selection (gymnasts, coaches and officials) communicated to athletes & coaches no later than Wednesday 17 th September 2025.
	General public announcement of the team will be no later than the WC 6 th October 2025.
12. Appeals	Appeals may only be submitted from midday on 18 th September 2025 until 5pm on 21 st September 2025 for non-selected gymnasts on the grounds that the process outlined within this selection policy has not been adhered to.
	Appeals must be submitted in writing by the gymnast (personal coach if under 18 years) and sent to performance@welshgymnastics.org between the timelines stated above. Appeals will be dealt with by an independent panel who were not initially involved in the decision-making process. All appeals will be heard and concluded by.
13. Injury and replacement	In the event of an injury and/or the need for replacement, the selection panel will decide about bringing the gymnasts listed as a (Non- travelling) reserve into the team at any time.
